ENGINEERED HARDWOOD





Engineered wood flooring is constructed from multiple plies of wood with a hardwood top layer. Below the top layer, cross layers of plywood are pressed to create a strong, stable core that is further reinforced by a layer of hardwood backing on the bottom. This multi-ply structure traditionally gives engineered wood the flexibility to be installed in basements, over concrete subfloors and over radiant heating systems.

Species

Armstrong Flooring offers a wide selection of wood species. The natural wood characteristics of each species offer a variety of stylish options to suit your individual needs.






